#### ABOUT THE ARTIST

Ayla Costello is a Traditional Owner from Quandamooka (Moreton Bay), Meanjin, Queensland.

Working alongside Aunts and Uncles, she has built up her skills as an indigenous artist and is growing her understanding of the Jandai language. By spending time with her Grandfather, she has learned the stories of the land and the history of Quandamooka Country.

#### Yaraman biriyinjili biyigi

My intention with the design of the Rockinghorse Jersey (Yaraman biriyinjili biyigi) was to combine elements of the team, music and the mascot. The horse is covered in depictions of meeting places/ corroborees, representing the team's spirit and unity. The yellow oval in the centre of the artwork is representative of the ball, and the rows of dots that run perpendicular up the sides portray the stud marks left by the players boots. Across the background, circles depict vinyls. The lines of dots in the background are reminiscent of the brainwaves that music creates when listened to. The horse itself is painted with rough strokes, making it look aged,

#### A DAY OF CELEBRATION

I acknowledge the Turrbal people as the Traditional Owners and true sovereigns of the land now known as Enoggera. We pay our respects to Elders from all nations - and to their Elders past, present and future. Today we also want to acknowledge the role that indigenous people have played in the development of Aussie Rules Football.

Welcome and thank you for coming along to Everton Wolves JAFC, Enoggera for the 2023 Brisbane Reclink Community Cup. This year we celebrate 30 years since the event was first created and 8 years since we started the event here in Brisbane in 2016. It's incredible to have many of the same people still involved in the event today.

I'd like to give a huge shout out to those people that help put this event together, this year and every year. There is so much planning and organising that goes on behind the scenes to make the Reclink Community Cup happen.

It just wouldn't be possible without the wonderful Organising Committee who give up their own time to make it happen — the support, grace and dedication you show during training, planning and today is just amazing. Thank you. Thank you also to all our amazing volunteers on the ground making everything work! We couldn't do it without any of you! From humble beginnings, Community Cup started in 1993 as a charity football match at a small suburban ground in Melbourne, raising \$500 for charity.

Since then, it has evolved and grown with matches played across the county. Who will reign supreme today!? Will it be the Brisbane Lines take out the title again or will they be challenged by the Rocking Horses? I can't wait to find out.

A key fixture on the calendar, the Reclink Community Cup is a wonderful day to come together and celebrate music, food, family, footy, have some fun and raise some money. With events scheduled across the country, this year we aim to raise more than \$200K for Reclink Australia. The funds raised here today support our work in creating and running sporting events and programs for people who are marginalised and disconnected from the community. We work with people who are suffering the impacts of trauma, domestic violence, people who have a drug and alcohol addiction, who are homeless, or long-term jobless, people with a disability and who are disconnected or abandoned, young people who are in trouble with the justice system, members of our Indigenous community ...the list goes on.

But we don't do this alone. We work in partnership with over 500 local community service agencies (shout out to our partners who are here today – thank you!) to provide sport and recreation opportunities for hundreds of thousands of participants who are finding things tough.

You might be here today to catch up with friends or enjoy the atmosphere. Our objective is to evoke those same feelings of connection and belonging for our participants to deliver - better physical health, better mental health and greater social inclusion.

All proceeds from today's match will help us to continue to deliver sports and recreation programs right here in Queensland that meet the needs of the people and communities we work with.


rustic and vintage; reminiscent of the Rockinghorse Records Store and its many years in Meanjin (Brisbane). Hoof prints travel across the artwork, carving out the team's path to victory.

#### **Meanjin Binang**

The Brisbane Lines Jersey (Meanjin binang) was designed with the aim to link modern day elements of the music and radio industry with dreamtime stories. I interpreted the Brisbane Lines team in multiple ways, combining Meanjin (Brisbane), music lines and sound waves. A major dreamtime story for First Nations people nationwide, is the rainbow serpent. Carving out the land and the Brisbane River, the rainbow serpent flows through the centre of the artwork. The rainbow

serpent is a pivotal figure for aboriginal people, as he is the creator and giver of water. His giving nature is represented through the team, who dedicate their time to the community off field. The serpent is also a daunting figure, intimidating other teams. A soundwave travels along the base of the jersey, with stories surrounding it. Towards the top of the artwork, stories surround the serpent. This represents the radio waves that share modern day stories and the dreamtime stories the Quandamooka people shared. The snake wraps around circle encasing rings. Each ring represents the generations of aboriginal people who inhabited Meanjin, and are representative of the Yuggera, Turrbal and Quandamooka peoples. Each tribe is depicted by a circle.




